Program Notes

During the years from the late 1920's to the early 1950's, hundreds of "Big Bands" traveled throughout the country bringing their exciting brand of popular music to ballrooms, night clubs and auditoriums in towns both large and small. The most popular of these bands could also be heard live on radio remotes and via their fast selling phonograph records. The leader's of these bands became stars who were known throughout the world and several of the bands were featured in Hollywood movies.

Undoubtedly the most famous of all the "Big Bands" was the Glenn Miller Orchestra and their biggest hit record was "In The Mood". Andy Clark's arrangement closely follows the original and retains all of the magic that has made "In The Mood" the signature sound of the "Big Band Era".

Rehearsal Suggestions

Please note, there is no Oboe part to this arrangement. It is the arrangers opinion that there was absolutely nothing in the original arrangement that could be enhanced by having it performed on a Oboe and therefore no part was written.

You may find it helpful to have the saxophone and trumpet soloists come to the front and perform the solos on a microphone. Chord symbols have been included on the solo parts, but you may find that because these solos are so well known, you may wish to have the students play the transcribed solos almost verbatim.

The String Bass/Bass Guitar part is very necessary to this arrangement and should not be considered optional. However, realizing that for some performances it will be impossible to have a String Bass/Bass Guitar available, we have printed the regular Tuba part and a String Bass Substitute part back-to-back. Whenever a String Bass or Bass Guitar is available, the Tubas should play the regular Tuba part.

The mallet percussion part is written entirely for Vibraphone. If you have extra mallet players and instruments, it would be nice to double many of the parts on Bells and/or Xylophone. However, the long sustained chords which the vibes play with the lower brass should not be doubled by other mallet instruments. It will probably sound best if the motor is turned off on the Vibraharp.

Should you happen to have a keyboard and/or guitar player available, the parts which go to the original published dance band arrangement will work perfectly well with this arrangement.

Since this is one of the most recognized arrangements ever written, there are many good recordings available for style study. In addition, the publisher of this concert band arrangement also has a superb full length recording of this exact arrangement. Have Fun!

Andy Clark

The Arranger

Andy Clark is a composer/arranger with a diverse background of musical and publishing experiences. A native of Alva, Oklahoma, Andy spent 4 years as chief arranger and featured trombonist and drummer with the U.S. Air Force "CONAC BAND". After his discharge, Andy was a very successful high school band director and music supervisor for the Rose Hill, Kansas Public Schools. In 1976 he resigned his teaching position to devote full time to a growing music publishing business, Norman Lee Publishing.



As a composer and arranger, Andy has now had over 100 band numbers published with 5 publishers and has served as a clinician at events in 28 states. Until the summer of 1988, Andy continued to perform professionally and was the leader of "Andy Clark & the KLEO Radio Orchestra," a 15-piece big band comprised primarily of professional players in the Wichita, Kansas area. As a composer/arranger Andy has had over 100 band pieces published and has served as a clinician in 28 states. In July of 1988 Andy joined the management staff at C.L. Barnhouse Company where he continues to help select, edit and write music for many of the Barnhouse band and orchestra series, especially those at the elementary and junior high levels.
