ABOUT THE COMPOSER



Larry Neeck is an internationally recognized composer, with more than one hundred works for concert band and jazz ensemble published by C.L. Barnhouse Company. As a composer, he has been commissioned numerous times to write for concert band, jazz ensemble, and orchestra, and often works as a guest conductor and clinician. Annually, he receives ASCAP awards for his compositions.

His CDs, "Swing Machine," recorded by the Studio "A" Big Band, and "Midnight Escape," recorded by the Washington Winds are available from Walking Frog Records. His music has also been heard on PBS television.

Mr. Neeck holds a B.A. in Music from the University of Pittsburgh, and an M.M. in Music Education from the Eastman School of Music. He is a member of the American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers (ASCAP), Music Educators National Conference (MENC), New York State School Music Association (NYSSMA), and the New York State Band Directors Association (NYSBDA).

In addition to composing, Mr. Neeck teaches instrumental music in the Webster (NY) Central School District. He directs concert bands, jazz ensembles, and is co-founder and director of the Willink Middle School Student/Parent Band.

PROGRAM NOTES


Commissioned in honor of a beloved band director, **Force of Destiny** is an upbeat celebration of the meaning of life, and the pursuit of one's destiny.

The introductory measures foreshadow the lyrical themes of the middle section of the piece. Begin slowly and gently, with attention paid to the soloists. An immediate tempo change occurs at m. 5, and this new tempo should be sustained throughout the first section of the piece (m. 5-64). Pay careful attention to dynamics and articulations, so that the melodies will stand-out, while the contrast between lyrical and martial passages will be evident. The climax of this section occurs at m. 65, with an immediate change in tempo and dynamics.

The middle section of the piece (m. 65-89) should be played expressively and lyrically, with the solos emphasized and supported. Bring-out the countermelodies where they occur (for example bassoon, tenor sax, horn, and euphonium at m. 71). The full ensemble starts softly at m. 77, and gradually builds to a strong climax at m. 89.

M. 89-120 is a recapitulation of the "A" section of the piece. Again, be sure that the melodies are prominent. The ritard (m. 119) slows the tempo dramatically, and leads to the majestic and triumphant conclusion of the work.
