### Program Notes

The classic Russian ballet "The Nutcracker" by Pyotr Ilyich Tchaikovsky is performed countless times each year during the holiday season. Although the original 1892 production was not a success, the ballet has enjoyed enormous popularity since the 1960s in the United States.

**Rockin' Nutcracker** is an arrangement of themes from Tchaikovsky's score in a uniquely American popular style. Written for the developing concert band, **Rockin' Nutcracker** features three popular melodies from the ballet. We hope you enjoy "The Nutcracker"...American style!

### Note To Conductor

The first four bars should be performed in a traditional orchestral style reminiscent of the original ballet. The rock style beginning in m. 5 should be in direct contrast!

The staccato articulations beginning at m. 25 should be very light. If a pianist is available, you may wish to use the optional piano in this particular section. The triangle should also play a prominent role.

The style changes once again beginning at m. 34. This setting of the classic Trepak melody should be in a fast and driving rock style. Please allow the percussion to provide the drive and momentum through careful balance. In a rock style, the percussion is typically stronger in the overall balance. As an option, you may wish to use a drum set strategically placed on the stage for effect and audibility.

Above all else, have fun!

I hope that you and the band enjoy the preparation and performance of **Rockin' Nutcracker**. Best wishes for a wonderful holiday performance!



### About the Composer




Robert W. Smith (b. 1958) is one of the most popular and prolific composers of concert band and orchestral literature in America today. He has over 600 publications in print with the majority composed and arranged through his long association with Warner Bros. Publications and the Belwin catalog.

Mr. Smith's credits include many compositions and productions in all areas of the music field. His original works for winds and percussion have been programmed by countless military, university, high school, and middle school bands throughout the United States, Canada, Europe, Australia, South America and Asia. His *Symphony #1 (The Divine Comedy)*, *Symphony #2 (The Odyssey)* and *Africa: Ceremony, Song and Ritual* have received worldwide critical acclaim. His educational compositions such as *The Tempest*, *Encanto*, and *The Great Locomotive Chase* have become standards for developing bands throughout the world. His numerous works for orchestras of all levels are currently some of the most popular repertoire available today. His music has received extensive air-play on major network television as well as inclusion in multiple motion pictures. From professional ensembles such as the United States Navy Band and the Atlanta Symphony to school bands and orchestras throughout the world, his music speaks to audiences in any concert setting.

As a conductor and clinician, Mr. Smith has performed throughout the United States, Canada, Japan, Europe and Australia. He is the principal conductor of the American Symphonic Winds and the American Festival Philharmonic Orchestra, professional recording ensembles based in Washington D. C. He has recently completed production of *Symphony No. 3 (Don Quixote)*, the fourth in a series of compact disc recordings of his best-known works for concert band. In addition, he is co-creator of the Expressions Music Curriculum. This comprehensive Pre-K through 12 music program includes *Band Expressions*, an innovative new approach to teaching music through the band.

Mr. Smith is the Vice President of Product Development and is an exclusive composer for the C. L. Barnhouse Company and Walking Frog Records. In addition, he is currently teaching in the Music Industry program at Troy University in Troy, Alabama. His teaching responsibilities are focused in music composition, production, publishing and business.
