Notes

George Philipp Telemann (1681-1767) was a famous German Baroque musician, friend of George Frederick Handel, and godfather of Carl Philipp Emmanuel Bach, son of Johann Sebastian Bach.

As composer, Telemann was prolific, writing an enormous body of work: 1,043 church cantatas, over 600 orchestral suites, 46 settings of the Passion, more than 40 operas, plus many secular cantatas and incidental works.

He was very popular during his lifetime, serving many courts and churches. He was also commercially active in publishing much of the music that he wrote.

Telemann's style combines the German Protestant Baroque with the lighter Italian and French *style galant*.

The beauty of *Aria* will be best served if all players strive for a *cantabile* performance. As the title suggests, this is a vocally inspired composition. Even in the absence of slurs (e. g., the bass quarter notes at measure 11), the notes should be *tenuto* and connected.

The chorale-like melodies (at measures 11, 19, 25, 37, 43, and 47) should be played very expressively and *sostenuto*.
