PROGRAM NOTE

English Country Settings is based on three traditional songs from the British Isles: “May Day Carol,” “O Waly Waly,” and “The Ash Grove.” The first theme of the serenade is based on “May Day Carol,” of which there are many variants. The current version is one found in some older editions of American childrens’ songbooks and recordings (*More Songs To Grow On*, Folkway Records). Both “O Waly Waly” (better known as “The Water is Wide”) and the Welsh folksong “The Ash Grove” were made known chiefly by their distribution in numerous vocal and instrumental arrangements. “O Waly Waly,” first disguised in f minor (measure 40), later appears in its true key of Bb major (trombones, measure 76) as accompaniment to the “May Day Carol.” The jig is a short set of variations on “The Ash Grove,” cast in lively triple meter.

PERFORMANCE NOTES

A solo oboe may be used at the pick-up to measure five, with first clarinet entering on the pick-up to measure nine. The first clarinets can double second and third clarinets during the oboe solo if desired. Cues, *ad libitum*, and *divisi* passages are optional; to be used as needed to suit the balance and instrumentation of the performing ensemble. The serenade can be played with great warmth and expression. The jig should be lively but never heavy-handed. Intensity and excitement should build continuously from the *capriccioso* at measure 158 until the end. If desired, the conductor can pull back slightly at measure 194, just prior to the final romp (*piu animato*). Although arranged as a one-movement work, the settings may be performed separately. The serenade, in particular, would be a suitable contest selection where a moderate tempo and quiet ending are needed to offer a balanced program.

THE COMPOSER

Pierre LaPlante, of French-Canadian descent, was born in Milwaukee and grew up in Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin. He attended the University of Wisconsin-Madison, where he earned his bachelors and masters degrees in music. His many years teaching at the elementary, high school, and college levels, include classroom, instrumental, and vocal music instruction. Mr. LaPlante, a bassoonist, performs with the Beloit-Janesville Symphony Orchestra. Compositions include works for band, orchestra, and chorus, solo literature, and chamber music. His works appear frequently on state contest lists. Mr. LaPlante teaches in the Pecatonica School District of Wisconsin. He is a member of the MENC, Wisconsin Music Educators Conference, and the Wisconsin Youth Band Directors Association. Pierre, his wife Laurie, and their daughters, Amy and Elizabeth, live in Blanchardville, Wisconsin.
